**RULES & REGULATIONS:**

- Spaces provided at the Blacksmith Shop/Polly's are first come, first serve and limited to 20 spaces. Size is limited to no larger than 10x20 per person.
- People setting up on this area are responsible for setting up and removing ALL of their items after the sale and are solely responsible for any damage.
- Set up begins at 7am. All items/tables/trash MUST be removed no later than 2 pm.
- There are no cars/trucks allowed on the lawns/common. You must park along the road.
- Anyone setting up at the Blacksmith Shop/Polly's MUST be selling yard sale/thrift type items and priced accordingly. Arts, crafts, direct sellers/vendors and food/beverage items are prohibited.
- If I am setting up at my own property/home, I understand the risk associated with COVID-19 and having people gather at my property, and I accept that risk and hold harmless the Sutton Historical Society and any of its volunteers for any sickness or death that may occur as a result of choosing to participate in the Sutton Town Wide Yard Sale.
- I will let shoppers know of any socially distance guidelines or mask policies I have for my own property upon their arrival.
